From the Desk of the Pastor ...

I remember sitting outside my college library my freshmen year reading my introduction to psychology textbook. The section I was reading covered the difference between goal setters who achieved their goals and those who did not. The essential difference was the former set realistic goals while the latter set unrealistic ones. Those who set realistic goals were stretched and challenged, having met those just-out-of reach goals through sacrifice. Those who did not set goals that were hopelessly out of reach from when they started. They often became discouraged and quit.

Sitting there I realized the truth of what I was reading. The key was learning how to set goals that were tough, but not too tough, doable versus next-to-impossible. Over time I have come to see that those who eventually attain what seems unattainable did so because they set and achieved incremental goals that coalesced to put them in shooting distance of the seemingly impossible. These people had to become someone they were not at the outset.

While being no expert, I have learned that the gift is not in meeting an individual goal or a group of goals. The real gift is developing the ability to adapt and change. It is a transferable quality whether one wants to shave 3 inches off their waistline or learn to play the guitar. Discipline and patience are essential.

Though I love achieving goals, I am often challenged by the question, "To what end?" I am reminded that as Christians we need the LORD to guide us to the appropriate goals and trust Him to equip us to meet them. Becoming a more patient person or learning to love like Christ also takes time. We don't change overnight. Instead of trying to eliminate anger in your life in one week, try seeking to eliminate your road rage first and then move on to quelling anger in another area of your life. Lean into Christ the whole way. Don't know where you need changing? Ask the Lord. He will let you know.


